

UNITED TO FIGHT CASTLEMAN DISEASE

ACCELERATE is the first-ever global patient registry for Castleman disease. The goal is to combine medical data from hundreds of patients so that researchers can discover patterns and clues that may help physicians better understand and treat Castleman disease.

Patients from around the world can enroll online. Once enrolled, medical data is collected, de-identified, and entered into a database by the team at the University of Pennsylvania.

ENROLLING WITH ACCELERATE

Participation in the ACCELERATE registry is entirely voluntary. Patients must have a pathology report that suggests Castleman disease and sign an informed consent form to be eligible for enrollment. CDCN respects your privacy, and all patients are de-identified to maintain confidentiality. We hope you'll consider signing up for the registry and becoming a part of this initiative.
